U on November 18 in North America and November 30 in PAL regions.[1][2][3][4][5]  
Black Ops II is the ninth5 , £ game in the Call of Duty franchise of video games,  
a sequel to the 2010 game Call of Duty: Black5 , £ Ops and the first Call of Duty  
game for the Wii U. A corresponding game for the PlayStation Vita, Call5 , £ of D  
uty: Black Ops: Declassified, was developed by nStigate Games and also released  
on November 13.&lt;/p&gt;  
&lt;p&gt;The game&#39;s campaign follows up5 , £ the story of Black Ops and is set  
in the late 1980s and 2025. In the 1980s, the player switches5 , £ control between  
n Alex Mason and Frank Woods, two of the protagonists from Black Ops, while in 2  
025, the player assumes5 , £ control of Mason&#39;s son, David (codenamed &quot;Se) Tj  
Nicaraguan arms dealer5 , £ and later terrorist, who is responsible for kidnappin  
g David in the 80s and later sparking a Second Cold War in5 , £ 2025. The campaign  
features non-linear gameplay and has multiple endings.[6] Locations featured in  
the game include Angola, Myanmar, Afghanistan, Nicaragua,5 , £ Pakistan, the Caym

with Activision promising that the follow-up would bring &quot;meaningful innova  
tion&quot; to the Call of Duty franchise. Black Ops5 , £ II is the first game in t  
he series to feature futuristic warfare technology and the first to present bran  
ching storylines5 , £ driven by player choice as well as selecting weapons before  
starting story mode missions. It also offers a 3D display5 , £ option. The game wa  
s officially revealed on May 1, 2012, following a set of leaked information rele
