<p>In every single other category, the comparisons are borderline absurd.
<p>Messi could finish his career with three times as many goals as Maradona and fou
<p>r times as many trophies. Some of those gulfs are products of era and opportunit

<p>Maradona was a son of the barrios, a kid from Argentina s suffocating s
<p>lums who outran poverty toward greatness. He was flawed, terribly flawed, and st
<p>ruggled with a drug addiction that ultimately derailed his career but millions
<p> of Argentines identified with the struggle. When he won it, temporarily, and li
<p>fted his countrymen with him to World Cup glory, they deified him.</p>
