dissolved (lost professional status).</p><p>The football club of the Ukrainian post-Soviet period was created in 1993 and brought to Kyiv from💱 Boryspil by a geological company Geoton which was one of main sponsors of the Football Federation of Ukraine and Ukraine💱 national football team in the beginning. In 1995–2001 through a merger, the club was reconstituted by the Ministry of Defense💱 as a separate government enterprise[5] not part of the Central Sports Club of the Armed Forces of Ukraine. During that💱 period (1995–2001) it competed in the Ukrainian Top League under CSKA Kyiv brand as its senior (main) squad, while the💱 original army squad continued to compete in lower leagues. In 1995 it was relocated to Kyiv playing at CSK ZSU💱 Stadium and carried such names CSKA-Boryspil and CSKA, while the original FC CSKA Kyiv competing in lower leagues changed its💱 name to CSKA-2 as its reserve squad.[6] Due to difficulty of financing, the ownership of senior squad was transferred to💱 the Kyiv city aut
